A: 3-day, 24 Hour Emergency Responder Training Program

--and---

B: 1-day, 8 hour, Emergency Responder **Refresher** Training Program

The NYPGA Emergency Response Committee is pleased to announce the availability of two types of Emergency Response training in September. One is the 24 Hour Emergency Responder Training Program that will be held September 10-11-12, 2019 and an the other is the Emergency Responder Refresher Training Program that will be held September 12 (only), 2019, also at the New York State Fire Academy in Montour Falls, NY. The refresher training (Sept 12) is an OSHA requirement for all responders who have taken the original 24 hour (3 day) course. The OSHA standard requires a refresher training every three years per CFR 1910.

Three-day Course Overview: The course will be based on the materials found in the Propane Emergencies Text, 3rd Edition. It will cover the physical characteristics of propane; the containers propane is stored in and the way propane is transported. The information will then be translated to hands-on and real-life ER training. Finally, there will a review of ER responses and incidents and a look into the future of Propane ER. This training can be applied to requirements for ER training in OSHA and NFPA standards.

- For those that have not taken the 3-say training from New York Propane Gas Association in the past, <u>plan to taking all three days of the training</u>: it is a two-day Emergency Response class PLUS the third day "refresher" class. You must have "24 hours" of training to be a "Responder" (CFR 1910)
- If you have taken the Emergency Response two-day class in the past, you should <u>plan on taking the third day</u> 'refresher class' only

Please bring appropriate "outdoor work type clothing", safety glasses, work gloves, and safety shoes. <u>Those planning to participate in the actual live burn 'evolutions' must supply their own full turnout gear and SCBA and be properly trained members of a fire department or other recognized emergency services organization. All students participating in the live burn must bring proof of proper training and current SCBA status. All others will be allowed to view the evolutions.</u>

Meals and lodging are available at the fire academy (see below), or you may choose to provide your own accommodations. There are motels located in Watkins Glen as well as in the nearby Horseheads area. **Please do not contact the Fire Academy directly for course registration or lodging**. The administration and residential building accommodates a total of 205 students in 75 double rooms and six 12-person dormitories. NOTE that there will be ___?__ OTHER courses, not related to New York Propane Gas Association, going on at the same time as our training this year. Rooms are assigned on a first-come/first served basis. Rooms are equipped with bed linens, blankets, pillows, towels, soap, a radio/alarm clock and phones. Televisions are located in common areas. The Academy does not have a laundry facility. If you arrive after 5:00 PM on the evening of Monday September 9, an envelope with your room key and meal cards will be left on the board located just inside the Academy's main front entrance. Breakfast is served at 7:00 AM (dining area is located on the ground level floor). Morning classes will start promptly at 8:00 AM. There will be signs noting the classroom assignment located in the Academy main entrance and at the classroom. Refresher students wishing to participate in the Responder training on Wednesday evening should meet in the academy dining room at 6:00 PM.

Outreach Training Guide Appendix B-12 Training Authorization Letter Policy

The **Training Authorization Letter** is instituted to ensure that the student firefighter, fire chief/department and the state fire instructor know that an individual has the authorization to attend the training course or courses delivered by the New York State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services, Office of Fire Prevention and Control and has obtained the necessary medical clearances to participate in strenuous firefighter training activities. In addition, 16 and 17-year-old firefighters must obtain approval from a parent or legal guardian prior to attending and participating in any and all training courses delivered by the Office of Fire Prevention and Control. No persons under the age of 16 may attend or participate in any training course delivered by the Office of Fire Prevention and Control.

A letter signed by a chief officer of the student's agency shall be submitted prior to participation in the following training programs delivered by the Office of Fire Prevention and Control:

- Firefighter I
- Firefighter II
- Intermediate Firefighter
- Firefighter Survival
- Firefighter Assist and Search (FAST)
- Truck Company Operations
- SCBA Confidence
- Confined Space Rescue
- Passenger Train Rescue
- Hazardous Materials Technician Basic
- Advanced Hazardous Materials Technician
- Flammable Gas Workshop
- Any new or future training courses requiring the use of Self Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA) or Supplied Air Respirators (SAR'S) in accordance with 29CFR1910.134

Procedure:

- 1. Courses Requiring the Use of Self Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA) or Supplied Air Respirators (SAR):
- A. The student firefighter shall submit to the state fire instructor a completed Training Authorization Letter signed by a chief officer and the student at registration for the first class session of any course requiring the use of SCBA or SAR (courses listed above).
- B. Any student firefighter that does not submit a completed letter will not participate in any evolution or course session requiring the use of SCBA or SARs and will not receive credit for that session.
- C. A Training Authorization Letter must be submitted for each course attended.
- 2. Course Attendance by 16 and 17 Year Old Firefighters:
- A. Student firefighters 16 or 17 years of age must complete a Training Authorization Letter. This letter must be signed by a chief officer, the student firefighter and parent or legal guardian and submitted at registration for the first session of any course offered by OFPC.
- B. Any 16 or 17-year-old student firefighter that does not submit a signed letter will not participate in the course.
- C. A Training Authorization Letter must be submitted for each course attended.

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
